

Short Film Project

Length: 10-30 minutes

Topic: Your choice. Pick a genre and run with it!

All members of your group need to appear in the movie at least once.

Your film should have a title at the beginning, and credits at the end with the actor names, director, etc. listed. Titles only at the beginning!

Your movie should use multiple camera angles to make it more interesting to watch. You may have to film the same scene more than once from different angles to accomplish this.

Include sound effects and background music where appropriate. There shouldn't any "boring" quiet spots in your movie.

Speaking of sound, make sure your sound is clear throughout the film. If a scene has too many distractions, redo it.

Make sure your story is interesting and captivating for your audience. Consider acting out a book you've read or a story you know. The audience should know what's going on from the actions and dialogue.

Your movie should have continuity. Consider bringing an outfit to wear each time to film so your characters are wearing the same clothes. You can keep them in the cabinet in the room. You can also store your props here.

Be sure to watch your movie with a critical eye. If a character is running, we don't need to see it for more than a few seconds. Keep the story going. If you're not sure, have someone outside of your group watch it and give you feedback.
